• Relaxing natural spring with hiking and waterfalls. Consists of 5 baths and a large, heated swimming pool.

Marymere Falls

Olympic National Frst, Port Angeles, WA

• A calm, one mile trail through well-maintained Fir, Cedar, Hemlock and Alder trees. The trail ends with a gorgeous waterfall and babbling river. A delightful place for an easy family trip.

FORKS

Ruby Beach

1 hour and 45 minutes away. Ruby Beach Rd, Forks, WA 98331

• Notable for its tide pools, natural driftwood and various sea stacks, Ruby Beach is the perfect place to get an up-close-and-personal taste of the Pacific Northwest.

Tree of Life

1 hour 55 minutes away. Ruby Beach Rd, Forks, WA 98331

• This breathtaking Sitka Spruce on the coast of Forks is elevated between two bluffs and houses a natural cavern beneath its roots, which are almost entirely visible to spectators.

Hoh Rain Forest

2 hours away. 18113 Upper Hoh Rd, Forks, WA 98331

• One of the largest temperate Rain Forests in the U.S., this stretch of land sits beside the Hoh River, a valley which was formed thousands of years ago by glaciers.

NEAH BAY

Makah Cultural and Research Museum

Opens at 10am. 1 hour and 40 minutes away. 1880 Bayview Ave, Neah Bay, WA 98357

• Interpreting and housing an abundance of 300-500 year old artifacts, this exhibit gives insight into the rich, historic culture of the communities' Native Ancestors.
